FAQ'S

What is the school schedule?

The school year typically runs from late August to mid June. The academic calendar, detailing holidays, vacations, early dismissals, and other noteworthy events, is available at www.allsaintsmaine.org

Do you offer before or after school child care?

Yes! We do have an extended day program for an additional fee.

Before school care is available at 7am. After school care is 2:45pm - 5:30pm.

We also offer childcare on some snow days, and during school vacation weeks.

Registration is required as spots are limited. We also offer summer camps!

Do you have Maine certified teachers?

All of our teachers are certified through the state of Maine and our school is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. Our Pre-K and extended day child care program is registered through the Department of Health and Human Services and is a member of Maine's Road to Quality.

How diverse is the student body?

Currently, based on data shared during enrollment, our student body is approximately 87% white, 3.7% Black/African American, 4% Asian, and 5.3% two or more races.

What if my family is not Catholic?

Rooted in the Catholic tradition, our school is open to families of any faith and offers a strong academic curriculum that incorporates spiritual and moral guidance based upon Biblical truth.

Our students are well-educated and well prepared to be kind, respectful, and faith-filled individuals who model the teachings of Jesus by serving the larger community, especially those in need.

We have many families of different Christian beliefs and other faiths. Currently, 73% of our student body is Catholic. The 27% non-Catholic population demonstrates our commitment to academic excellence.

Do you offer a bus?

Students travel from many surrounding communities. We do not have a community bus, we do have an Intercampus Bus that runs between our two buildings in the morning and in the afternoon.

What are the hours of operation?

Students may be dropped off at St. John's campus beginning at 7:30am.

School runs at St. John's campus from 7:50am to 2:30pm.

Drop off at St. Mary's campus begins at 7:45am including for Pre-K students. School runs at St. Mary's campus from 8:05am - 2:40pm

How much is tuition?

Tuition rates for the school year are posted on our website www.allsaintsmaine.org. For students in grades K-8, there is a discount for Catholic families registered with a local parish. A discount is also offered for families with multiple children.

Preschool and Pre-K: Tuition for Preschool (ages 3-4) and Pre-K (ages 4-5) is \$42.00 per day. Our program runs for 37 weeks of the year. Preschool offers a 3 day or 5 day program. The Pre-K program runs 5 days a week (7:45am - 2:45pm). Preschool begins when a student is 3 years old and fully potty trained.

Payments:

Once a tuition contract is signed, tuition payments are made on-line either once a year, twice a year, or in ten monthly payments. Tuition payments begin in July before school begins and are completed by April.

Do you offer financial aid?

Yes for students in grades K - 8. All Saints is committed to making Catholic education affordable for all families in the greater Bangor area. To the extent that our funds permit, assistance is available based on financial need and is determined through an on line application. Applications are reviewed on a first come - first served basis. The deadline to apply is April 14, 2025.

Do you have a lunch program?

Yes! Hot lunches are provided by Fairmount Market for about \$6 a meal. Parents can select which days they'd like to order on a monthly basis. Students should bring a water bottle and a snack to school each day.

How do we order uniforms?

Students have uniform options: formal, casual and gym class. Uniforms can be ordered through Flynn and O'Hara <https://flynnohara.com>. We also have a Uniform Shop with gently used items at our St. John's Campus (166 State St.). We will announce when it is open during the year, or please call to make an appointment to stop in 942-0955.

What else do we offer?

We offer many extracurricular activities including ski club, robotics team, youth choir, mathcounts, and many seasonal sports such as soccer, basketball, cheering, baseball, softball and track.

How do I enroll?

Complete an Admissions Inquiry Form found on our website. Families will receive an email invitation with an application link. Once you are invited to enroll, there is a non-refundable \$200 enrollment fee and other needed paperwork such as immunization records, previous school records if applicable, tuition payment agreement, and a copy of the child's birth certificate (for K students).

Who can volunteer in the school?

Our families make a commitment to serve 20 volunteer hours over the course of the year (10 community and 10 in fundraising). There are many ways to participate! Before one can volunteer, they must go through a 3-step process: application, background check, and participate in a "Protecting God's Children" training session.

How do you communicate with parents and families?

The school uses a variety of ways to connect with families to ensure timely communication. Our FACTS Student Information Database houses announcements, a calendar of events, important documents, lunch ordering, grades and teacher email addresses. A newsletter is emailed weekly from the principal on Sundays or follow our school or PTO Facebook pages. Teachers especially in younger grades, share classroom updates weekly.
